Objectives:

- The mechanisms of enhancing and promoting Tolerance Culture.
- Introducing new approaches to promote tolerance culture.
- Being introduced to the landmarks in Sharjah governorate as buildings established, traditional houses, squares and government offices, the different museums, universities and Scientific and Cultural bodies.

Organization:

In cooperation between the Arab Regional Office & United Arab Emirates (UAE) Scout Association.

Participants:

Each National Scout Organization – worldwide- is invited to nominee **one male rover** to participate in the event according to the following criteria:

- 1. The nominated Rover should have interest in promoting tolerance and has an experience on its importance.
- 2. He should be a registered member in his NSO.
- 3. Age between 18-23 years old
- 4. The applicant/s must be nominated by his NSO officially.
- 5. With good command of English to be able to exchange his experience with others.

6. Deadline is Fri. 20th of Dec. 2019

- **7.** The participant/s **should provide Arab Support Center** with the followings:
 - A Complete registration endorsed stamped by the NSO should be submitted by email arab@scout.org
 - A colored scanned copy of the nominated rover's valid passport (6 months at least).
 - 2 colored (passport sized) recent photograph (4×6) with a white background in the official scouting uniform.

Sponsorship & Costs:

- The sponsorship will cover travel expenses of <u>ONE ROVER</u> (economy class) from all applying WOSM NSOs that will be sent in due time as an e-ticket.
- Each participant should cover by himself any extra days before or after the event duration.
- An additional rover could participate in case covering his round ticket by himself or his NSO.

Visa/s:

• Emirates Scout Association will issue all necessary entry visa/s for all the approved participants.

Worksheets and presentations required:

Each participant (contingent) should prepare a presentation (10 minutes) on the theme of the event including (pics, videos ..etc.).
 and the experience of his country in the named field to share with others

Cultural exchange:

 An International Evening where all the participants are invited to present different types of their traditional dishes, folklore, songs, dances, scouting souvenirs, gifts...etc).

What is to bring? and what should you share?

- Traditional costume which is unique to the country as part of the International Evening.
- A presentation (including: CD, video, Guidelines, documents ...etc) on the Relevant topic of the event as well as to introduce the culture of his country to share during the event.
- · Scouting Uniform for the official activities.
- **2** flags of the participant's country 60×120 cm (will be delivered and left in the venue hosting the event).
- **2** personal recent colored photos in scouting uniform
- A copy of the renewed scouting curriculum being applied in his NSO of to the library of Sharjah Commissionerate.
- Identifying the size/s of T-shirt, training suit (international Sizes)
- Documents, publications, handouts, posters, video tape, CD, and traditional dishes, folkloric dancing or songs...etc for exhibition and for any audiovisual presentation exchange.
- Swimming suite, suitable cloths for water and beach games.
- Comfortable shoes for walking in the desert and personal equipments.

The Climate
